

1. ACCEPTANCE OF TERMS

Taylor Truck Line Inc., a Minnesota corporation ("COMPANY") and TMW Systems, Inc., a Delaware corporation ("TMW"), collectively, "THE PARTIES" provides its service to you, ("you" or "your") subject to the following Terms of Service ("TOS" or "Terms of Service"), which may be updated by us from time to time without notice to you. In addition, when using particular COMPANY owned or operated services, you shall be subject to any posted guidelines or rules applicable to such services, which may be posted from time to time. All such guidelines or rules are hereby incorporated by reference into the TOS. THE PARTIES may also offer other services that are governed by different terms of service.

2. DESCRIPTION OF SERVICE

A. The PARTIES provide users with access to a variety of resources, including communications tools, forums, services, personalized content and branded programming through its network of properties which may be accessed through any various mediums or devices now known or hereafter developed (the "Service").

B. You also understand and agree that the Service may include advertisements which are necessary for the PARTIES to provide the Service. You also understand and agree that the Service may include certain communications from THE PARTIES, such as service announcements, administrative messages and newsletters, and that these communications are considered part of membership and you will not be able to opt out of receiving them. Unless explicitly stated otherwise, any new features that enhance the current Service, including the release of new properties, shall be subject to the TOS.

C. You understand and agree that the Service is provided "AS-IS" and that THE PARTIES assume no responsibility for the timeliness, deletion, delivery or failure to store any user communications or personalization settings. D. You acknowledge and agree that the COMPANY has no control over the availability of the Services on a continuous or uninterrupted basis.

3. REGISTRATION OBLIGATIONS

In consideration of your use of the Service, you represent that you are of legal age to form a binding contract and are not a person barred from receiving services under the laws of the United States or other applicable jurisdiction. You also agree to: (a) provide true, accurate, current and complete information about yourself as prompted by the Service's registration form (the "Registration Data") and (b) maintain and promptly update the Registration Data to keep it true, accurate, current and complete. If you provide any information that is untrue, inaccurate, not current or incomplete, or THE PARTIES have reasonable grounds to suspect that such information is untrue, inaccurate, not current or

incomplete, THE PARTIES have the right to suspend or terminate your account and refuse any and all current or future use of the Service (or any portion thereof).

4. PRIVACY POLICY

Registration Data and certain other information about you is subject to the COMPANY's current Privacy Policy. You understand that through your use of the Service you consent to the collection and use (as set forth in the Privacy Policy) of this information, including the transfer of this information to the United States and/or other countries for storage, processing and use by the COMPANY and their affiliates.

5. MEMBER ACCOUNT, PASSWORDS AND SECURITY

You will receive a password and account designation upon completing the Service's registration process. You are responsible for maintaining the confidentiality of the password and account and are fully responsible for all activities that occur under your password or account. You agree to (a) immediately notify the Company of any unauthorized use of your password or account or any other breach of security, and (b) ensure that you exit from your account at the end of each session. The COMPANY cannot and will not be liable for any loss or damage arising from your failure to comply with this Section 5.

6. MEMBER CONDUCT

You understand that all information, data, text, software, music, sound, photographs, graphics, video, messages, tags, or other materials ("Content"), whether publicly posted or privately transmitted, are the sole responsibility of the person from whom such Content originated. This means that you, and not THE PARTIES, are entirely responsible for all Content that you upload, post, email, transmit or otherwise make available via the Service. THE PARTIES do not control the Content posted via the Service and, as such, do not guarantee the accuracy, integrity or quality of such Content. You understand that by using the Service, you may be exposed to Content that is offensive, indecent or objectionable. Under no circumstances will THE PARTIES be liable in any way for any Content, including, but not limited to, any errors or omissions in any Content, or any loss or damage of any kind incurred as a result of the use of any Content posted, emailed, transmitted or otherwise made available via the Service.

- j. interfere with or disrupt the Service or servers or networks connected to the Service, or disobey any requirements, procedures, policies or regulations of networks connected to the Service;
- k. intentionally or unintentionally violate any applicable local, state, national or international law, including, but not limited to, regulations promulgated by the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission, any rules of any national or other securities exchange, including, without limitation, the New York Stock Exchange, the American Stock Exchange or the NASDAQ, and any regulations having the force of law;
- l. provide material support or resources (or to conceal or disguise the nature, location, source, or ownership of material support or resources) to any organization(s) designated by the United States government as a foreign terrorist organization pursuant to section 219 of the Immigration and Nationality Act;
- m. "stalk" or otherwise harass another; and/or
- n. collect or store personal data about other users in connection with the prohibited conduct and activities set forth in paragraphs a through m above.

You acknowledge that THE PARTIES may or may not pre-screen Content, but that THE PARTIES and its designees shall have the right (but not the obligation) in their sole discretion to pre-screen, refuse, or move any Content that is available via the Service. Without limiting the foregoing, THE PARTIES and its designees shall have the right to remove any Content that violates the TOS or is otherwise objectionable. You agree that you must evaluate, and bear all risks associated with, the use of any Content, including any reliance on the accuracy, completeness, or usefulness of such Content. In this regard, you acknowledge that you may not rely on any Content created by THE PARTIES or submitted to THE PARTIES.

You understand that the technical processing and transmission of the Service, including your Content, may involve (a) transmissions over various networks; and (b) changes to conform and adapt to technical requirements of connecting networks or devices.

You understand that the Service and software embodied within the Service may include security components that permit digital materials to be protected, and that use of these materials is subject to usage rules set by THE PARTIES and/or content providers who provide content to the Service. You may not attempt to override or circumvent any of the usage rules embedded into the Service. Any unauthorized reproduction, publication, further distribution or public exhibition of the materials provided on the Service, in whole or in part, is strictly prohibited.

TMW grants you a personal, non-transferable and non-exclusive right and license to use the object code of its Software on a single computer; provided that you do not (and do not allow any third party to) copy, modify, create a derivative work from, reverse engineer, reverse assemble or otherwise attempt to discover any source code, sell, assign, sublicense, grant a security interest in or otherwise transfer any right in the Software. You agree not to modify the Software in any manner or form, nor to use modified versions of the Software, including (without limitation) for the purpose of obtaining unauthorized access to the Service. You agree not to access the Service by any means other than through the interface that is provided by TMW for use in accessing the Service.

16. SERVICES RELATING TO FINANCIAL MATTERS

The Service is provided for informational purposes only, and no Content included in the Service is intended for trading or investing purposes. 19. TRADEMARK INFORMATION

The COMPANY trademarks and service marks and other COMPANY logos and product and service names are trademarks of Taylor Truck Line Inc. (the "COMPAY Marks"). Without COMPANY's prior permission, you agree not to display or use in any manner the COMPANY Marks.

The TMW trademarks and service marks and other TMW logos and product and service names are trademarks of TMW Inc. (the "TMW Marks"). Without TMW's prior permission, you agree not to display or use in any manner the TMW Marks.

20. NOTICE AND PROCEDURE FOR MAKING CLAIMS OF COPYRIGHT OR INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY INFRINGEMENT

THE PARTIES respects the intellectual property of others, and we ask our users to do the same. THE PARTIES may, in appropriate circumstances and at its discretion, disable and/or terminate the accounts of users who may be repeat infringers. If you believe that your work has been copied in a way that constitutes copyright infringement, or your intellectual property rights have been otherwise violated, please provide THE PARTIES's Copyright Agent the following information:

You and THE PARTIES agree to submit to the personal and exclusive jurisdiction of the courts located within the county of Dakota County, Minnesota.

30. WAIVER OF SEVERABILITY OF TERMS

The failure of THE PARTIES to exercise or enforce any right or provision of the TOS shall not constitute a waiver of such right or provision. If any provision of the TOS is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the parties nevertheless agree that the court should endeavor to give effect to the parties' intentions as reflected in the provision, and the other provisions of the TOS remain in full force and effect.

31. NO RIGHTS OF SURVIVORSHIP AND NON-TRANSFERABILITY

You agree that your account is non-transferable and any rights to your account ID or contents within your account terminate upon your death. Upon receipt of a copy of a death certificate, your account may be terminated and all contents therein permanently deleted.

32. STATUTE OF LIMITATIONS

You agree that regardless of any statute or law to the contrary, any claim or cause of action arising out of or related to use of the Service or the TOS must be filed within one (1) year after such claim or cause of action arose or be forever barred.

33. HEADINGS

The headings and section titles in the TOS are for convenience only and have no legal or contractual effect.

34. VIOLATIONS

Please report any violations of the TOS to THE PARTIES.
